



Credit Card Convenience Fees Passed To Customers

Visa No Longer Accepted At Counter

Changes Effective July 1, 2009

The Orange County Clerk's Office has been forced to cut its budget by 27 percent due to recently passed legislation. We have had to take several measures to address such a drastic decrease.

One of those measures is to pass the \$3.99 credit card convenience fee, which we have long absorbed, to the customer, effective July 1.

The convenience fee for American Express, MasterCard and Discover will be passed to customers whether they are paying in person or online at myorangeclerk.com.

Visa does not allow convenience fees to be passed to customers paying in person. Therefore, we will no longer be accepting Visa at our counters, effective July 1. Customers paying online can continue to pay with Visa, including the \$3.99 convenience fee. Visa will also be accepted with phone payments.
